Pattern Skills

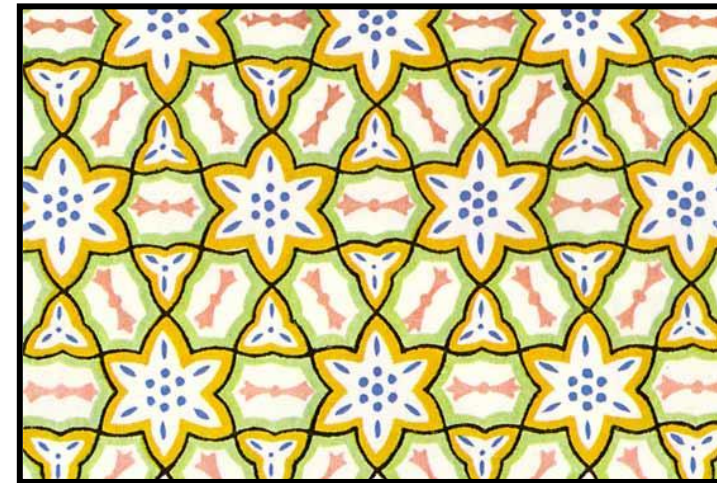
Observe patterns in the environment.

Create patterns with symmetry.



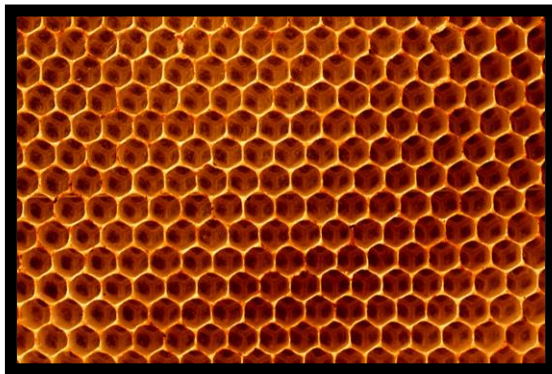
