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Our focus for this year


•Improve attendance and decrease the number of persistent absentees

We have noticed our school attendance is much better on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. It is much worse on a Friday.

It is so important your child attends on a Friday as there are some lessons your child will only have on a Friday. It is just as important as any other day.

As part of our attendance monitoring we look for patterns of absence for individual patterns and if your child is absent more on certain days of the week we will need to unpick this with you.

Please remember that the new attendance regulations are now in place.

Mr Thorne is our school's SENDCo (Special needs and disabilities coordinator). This means he is responsible for overseeing the provision for all children on the SEND Register.

Mr Thorne holds several other important roles in school such as:

Deputy Safeguarding Lead

Manging pupils' medical conditions and medicines

Line manger for the teaching assistant team

Geography subject lead

A typical day for Mr Thorne may include meeting with parents, holding an Annual Review for a child with an EHCP, observing a child in class, offering support to a member of staff who is supporting a child with SEND, delivering a TA training session and carrying out a dyslexia screen.
