**Dear Parents and Carers** 

A few reminders about ordering and payments.

## Breakfast Club

- Spaces can be booked and paid for on Arbor.
- If it is an emergency, your child can attend without booking but please send the £1.50 in cash with your child.
- Your child should not attend without the session being paid for.
- The school is able to keep the cost low as it works with the National Breakfast Programme who provide bagels and cereals at a very low cost.

## School Meals

- Meals need to be ordered by the Thursday of the week before on Arbor.
- If you do not order by this time you will need to send your child with a packed lunch.
- If you do not book a meal, we will not cook for your child, therefore we will call you and ask if you would like to bring a packed lunch to school or if you would like us to provide cereal and fruit for your child.
- If you are not eligible for free school meals, you need to pay for the meals at the time of ordering.
- If there is an outstanding debt on your child's account at the end of a week, we will not accept orders for the following week until that debt is cleared.
