Through the NHS Pharmacy First Service, Kamsons Pharmacy can provide treatment for a range of minor ailments without the need for a GP appointment, offering a convenient alternative for busy families. We understand that children may sometimes feel unwell, and it can be challenging for parents to secure GP appointments or find time outside their work schedules.

The Pharmacy First Service helps by allowing pharmacists to provide consultations and, where appropriate, treatments such as antibiotics for a selection of common conditions. Common Conditions Covered: Kamsons Pharmacy is equipped to support families with treatments for the following conditions: • Sinusitis (12 years and older) • Sore Throat (5 years and older) • Earache (1-17 years) • Infected Insect Bite (1 year and older) • Impetigo (1 year and older) • Shingles (18 years and older) • Urinary Tract Infection (women 16-64 years) This service could be particularly helpful for managing earaches and impetigo, two conditions that frequently affect young children.

How It Works: Parents and carers do not need an appointment; they can simply visit any Kamsons Pharmacy at their convenience for a consultation with one of our trained pharmacists. Our team is fully equipped to assess symptoms, recommend treatment, and, if appropriate, provide medication on the spot, ensuring children get timely care and reducing the pressure on GP services.
